There is a sample letter on the back you can use as a template. The letter should include the following information:

1. Date, location, name and brief description of the event that VAS participated in.
2. Names of the VAS members that were involved in the event.
3. An estimate of how many people came to the event.
4. The number of hours the members were there including setting up and breaking down the equipment.
5. How successful the event was, people's comments, etc.
6. If your organization has stationary please use it for this letter.
7. Be sure to sign the letter, give your title, and name of the organization.
